Rules for Official Scorekeeping & Announcing

- 1. No one under the age of 16 will be allowed to keep score or announce.**
- 2. No cheering, taunting, yelling, or outbursts of any kind will be permitted from persons at the official score tables.**
3. Scorekeepers and Announcers will not be permitted to answer questions for anyone except the Umpires.
4. Once the scorekeepers are given the line up to write in the official book no changes will be permitted to the batting order unless they are to move a LATE player to the bottom of the line up or REMOVE a player who has not shown up by their at bat. Coaches will be responsible for notifying the Opposing Team Manager and the Official Book in regards to such changes.
- 5. Scorekeepers and Announcers will not be permitted to notify any Manager or Umpire when players are batting out of order.** Should the scorekeeper be asked by the Umpire to identify the player who should be at the plate, then they may clarify the batting order for the Umpire.
6. Official scorekeepers must record the at bat in the box corresponding to the player physically at the plate and refrain from making changes to the line-up in attempt to “fix” or “correct” the batting order.
7. Announcers should announce the player names as they appear on the official line-up.
8. Scorekeepers must write at the top of the score sheet the Division of the game they are keeping score for (Ie. JR.-Tball, TBall, 8U, 10U, or 12U), Team Names (Home team on the Right side, Visitors on the Left side), Date, Time, and Field for each game. Simply writing the names of the players will not be permitted. Failure to indicate any of the aforementioned will result in incorrect standings.
- 9. For Kid Pitch divisions,** the scorekeeper must write the Name and Number of each Pitcher and indicate with an “X” the number of innings pitched. (For clarification on how to properly do this please ask a Board Member.)
- 10.**The final score should be written at the bottom of the score sheet.
- 11.**The official scorebook must remain at the scorekeepers table at all times.
- 12.**Coaches must sign the book after each game.
